Advanced reservations are encouraged.

A **credit card** number or advanced payment is required for the Monhegan Island Ferry and Puffin Watch and will hold tickets until 20 minutes prior to departure. Reservations are recommended for the Seal Watch, Lighthouse Cruise and Fall Coastal Cruises.

Credit cards will be charged 24 hours before scheduled departure time.

Cancellations are required 24 hours in advance of departure time for full refund. All other cancellations, unclaimed tickets and no-shows are non-refundable.

For **overnight ferry reservations** we require the name of your accommodation or rental agent on the Island.

Please **arrive at the dock 45** minutes prior to departure. Allow additional time if you have baggage.

Schedules, fares and fees are subject to change without notice. Fuel surcharges may be imposed if necessary.

Hardy Boat Cruises reserves the right to change or cancel any trip without notice.

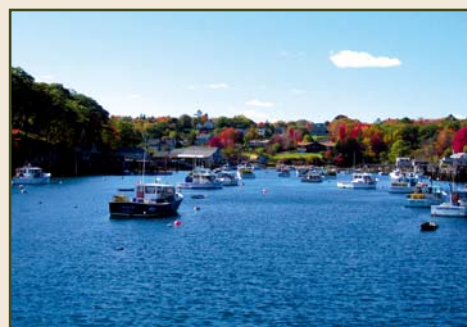

TO HARDY BOAT CRUISES

132 STATE ROUTE 32, NEW HARBOR MAINE 04554

DRIVING TIMES to New Harbor, ME:

from Portland, ME ~ 1 1/4 hours / from Augusta, ME ~ 1 hour

from Camden, ME ~ 1 hour / from Boston, MA 3 1/2 hours

Allow extra time for summertime traffic.

From the South:

From I-95 North, take Exit 44 to I-295 North (Portland). Take Exit 28 or 31 (Brunswick) to Coastal Route 1 North. Continue through Bath and Wiscasset. In Newcastle, turn right onto Business Route 1 (2nd right after the Dodge/Jeep dealership). Follow Business Route 1 to downtown Damariscotta. Turn right after the First National Bank onto Route 130 (Bristol Road). Continue for approximately 12 miles and turn left onto Route 32. Parking is at the baseball field (1/2 mile).

From the North:

Take Coastal Route 1 South to Waldoboro. Turn left onto Route 32 at Hannaford. Follow Route 32 for approximately 19 miles to New Harbor. Parking is located at the baseball field just beyond Shaw's Wharf Restaurant.

PARKING INFO

Parking is available around the corner from the dock at the old baseball field. Parking is \$3 per day / per vehicle. For overnight parking, fee is payable upon the first day of parking. **Cash only please.**

Please disarm your car alarm. Upon paying for your parking, you will receive a parking validation which you will need to collect your tickets (peak season only). We suggest driving to the dock, dropping off your passengers and baggage before returning to the parking lot to leave your car. The walk back to the dock is about 5 minutes. During the Spring and Fall, parking is payable at the ticket booth on the dock. Cars parked at Shaw's Wharf Restaurant will be towed at the owner's expense.



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
